INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE & STRATEGY

The Azzad Wise Capital Fund pursues long-term income and capital preservation by investing primarily in Islamic Bonds (Sukuk) and interest-free bank deposits and notes issued primarily by overseas banks in developing countries. A small portion of the Fund's assets may be invested in dividend yielding stocks. Using a thorough due diligence process, the investment team seeks to identify fixed income investments that are suitable for more conservative investors and in line with the Adviser's investment philosophy.

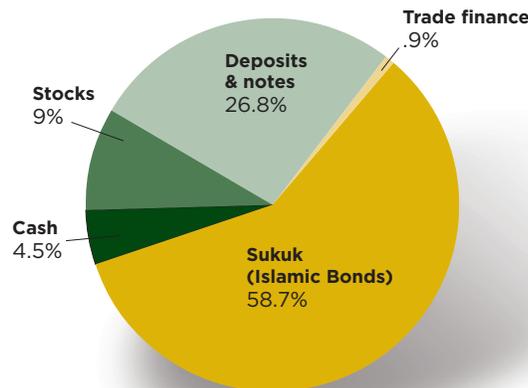

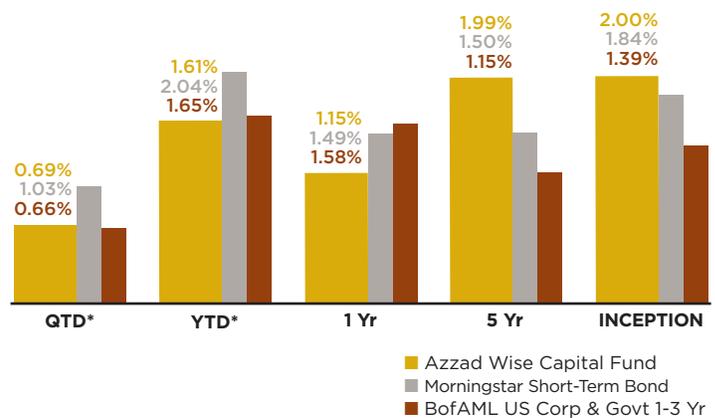
